- 7. Federal judiciary, the US Supreme Court and its impact on US politics
- 8. US economy, Anglo-Saxon socioeconomic model, position in the world economy
- 9. Federal states and their usual internal functioning
- 10. American political culture and its development, main values, political ideology, economic liberalism.
- 11. American foreign policy, its main doctrines and development, relation to international law
- 12. Political parties in the USA
